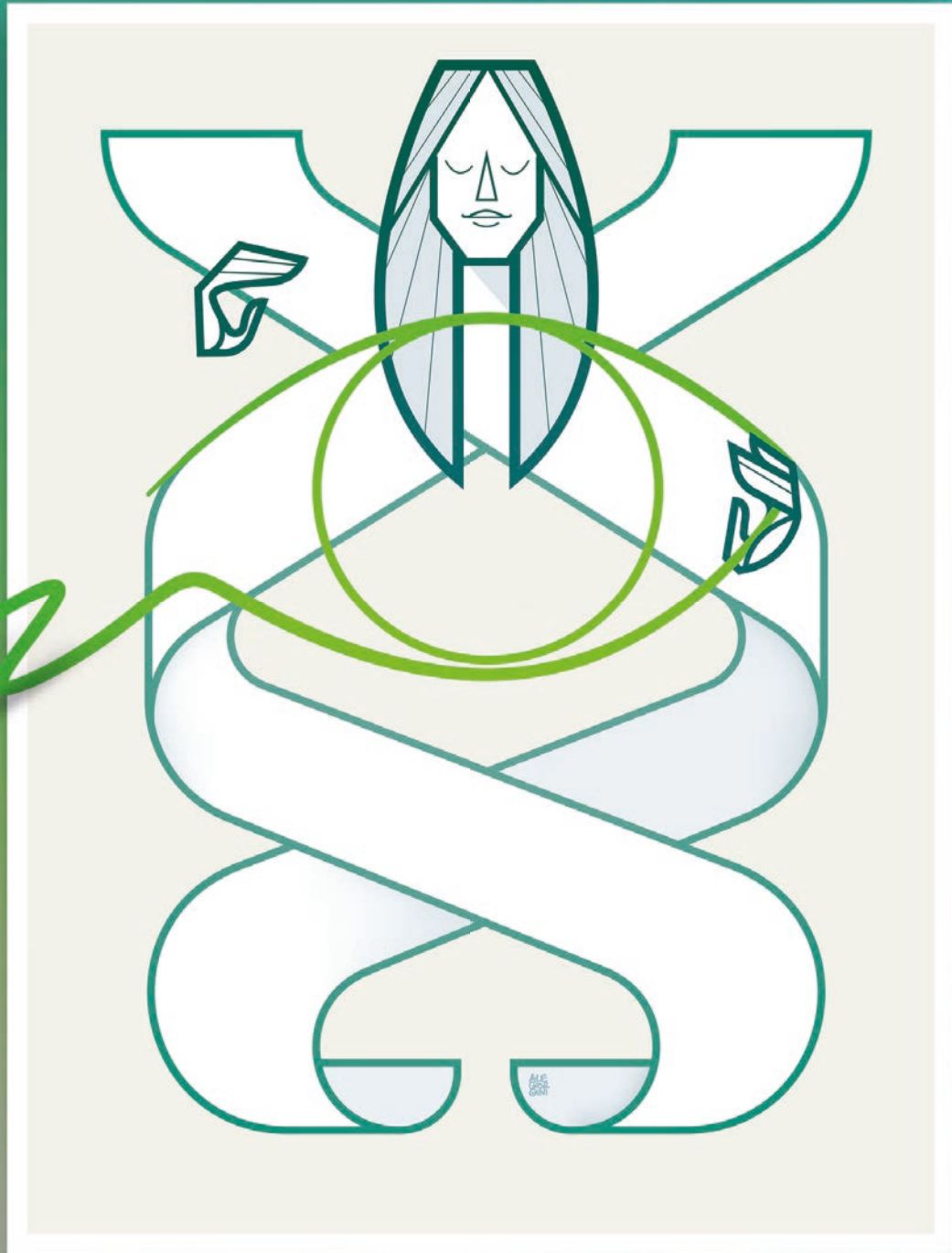

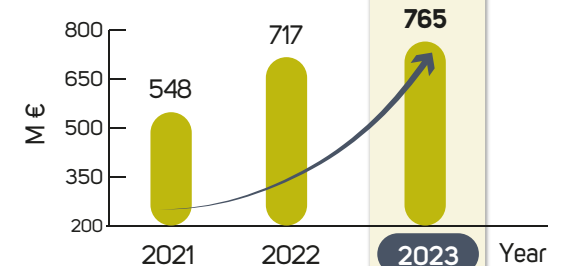

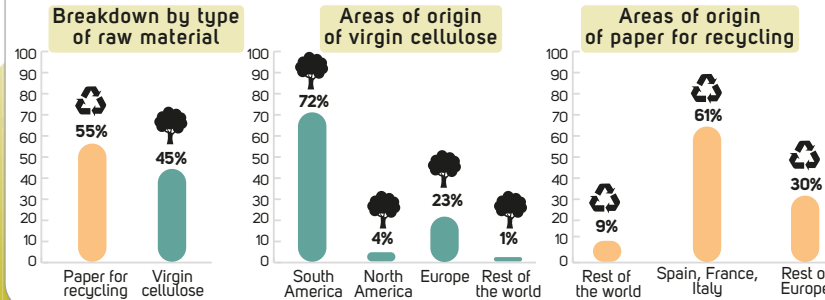

In 2023 100% of the trips to and from the Altopascio hub were made by BIO-LNG vehicles



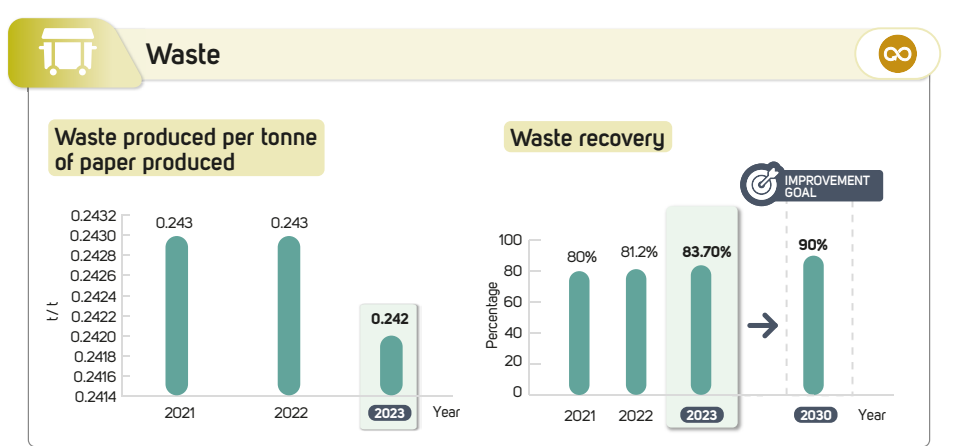
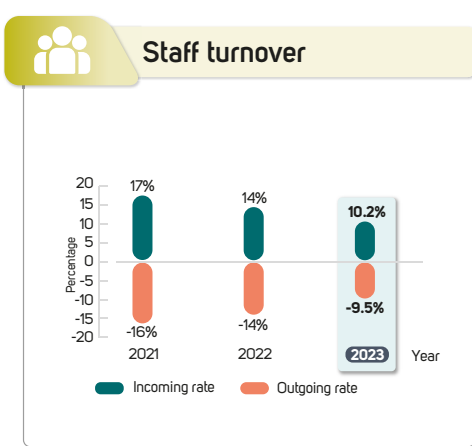
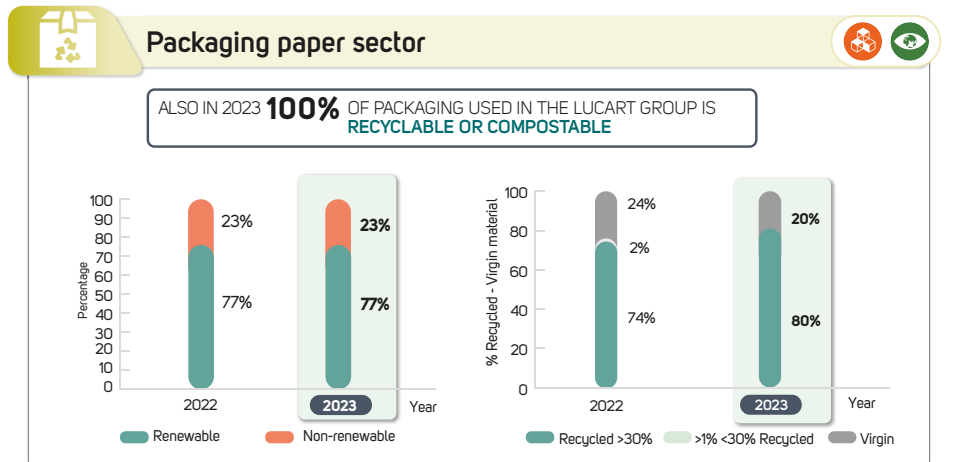
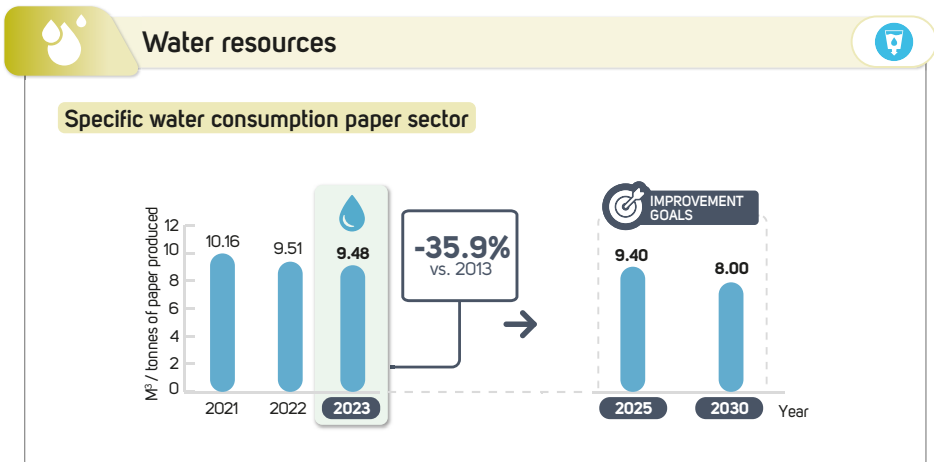
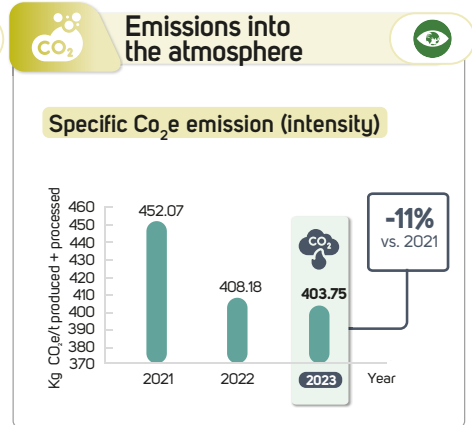
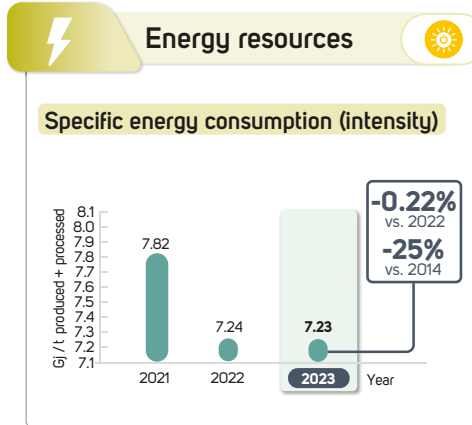
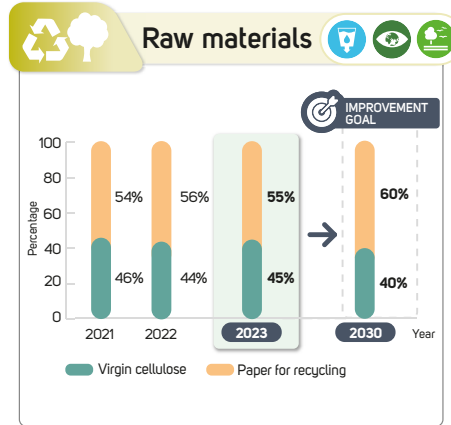
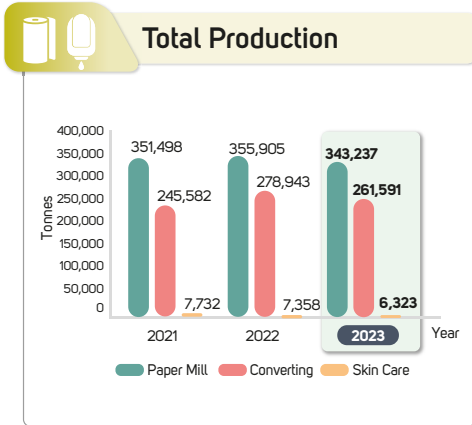
